- Use recommended lubricants for electric motor parts
- Manual parts can be wiped clean with disinfectant; avoid water in motor parts

- Ideal for grooming livestock such as sheep, goats, cattle, and horses
- Also used in pet grooming clinics for dogs, cats, and small animals
- Helps improve animal comfort and appearance during veterinary visits
