Nimesulide BP 400 mg + Paracetamol IP 1500 mg Veterinary Bolus

Description:

This veterinary bolus combines Nimesulide, a potent Non-Steroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drug (NSAID) with analgesic, anti-inflammatory, and antipyretic properties, and Paracetamol (Acetaminophen), a widely used analgesic and antipyretic agent. Together, they effectively alleviate pain, reduce inflammation, and control fever in large animals, making it ideal for managing musculoskeletal disorders, post-surgical pain, and other inflammatory conditions.

Specification:

- Appearance: White to off-white solid bolus
- Assay: Nimesulide 400 mg \pm 5%, Paracetamol 1500 mg \pm 5%
- Purity & Quality: As per British Pharmacopoeia (BP) and Indian Pharmacopoeia (IP) standards
- Packaging: Strips of 10 boluses, pack size 10 x 4 boluses

Indications:
