

Cuticle Scissor

Description

A **Cuticle Scissor** is a precision grooming tool designed to trim, shape, and remove excess cuticles, hangnails, and dead skin around the nail bed.

It features **sharp, fine, curved blades** that allow controlled and accurate cutting, making it an essential tool for manicure, pedicure, dermatology, and cosmetic grooming.

The lightweight design and ergonomic finger rings ensure smooth handling and reduced hand fatigue.

 - Anti-slip texture

Sizes & Shapes

- **Standard Length:** 3.5–4.5 inches
- **Blade Shapes:**
 - Curved
 - Straight
 - Extra-fine pointed
- **Handle Shapes:**
 - Small round rings
 - Ergonomic oval rings
 - Slim profile for controlled grip

Usage

- Trimming overgrown cuticles
- Removing hangnails
- Shaping nail edges in manicure/pedicure
- Cleaning dead skin around nail beds
- Suitable for salons, home grooming, cosmetic kits



Handling

- Hold scissors firmly using the ring handles
- Cut small sections at a time
- Avoid pulling or tearing the skin
- Use on softened cuticles after soaking hands or applying cuticle softener

Sterilisation & Cleaning

- Wash with warm water and gentle soap
- Dry completely to prevent rusting
- Sterilise using alcohol or disinfectant
- Store in a protective case to maintain blade sharpness

Advantages

- Accurate and clean trimming
- Compact and lightweight
- Hygienic stainless-steel construction
- Smooth cutting action due to fine blades
- Professional-level precision

Disadvantages

- Sharp tips require careful use
- Dropping may misalign the blades
- May cause injury if used incorrectly
- Requires regular cleaning for hygiene

Precautions

- Keep away from children
- Do not use on infected or inflamed skin
- Ensure proper sterilisation before each use
- Avoid cutting too close to living skin
- Check for blade alignment before using
