Aluminium Aerosol Spray Herbal Veterinary Product

Description

This product is a **herbal veterinary topical spray** formulated with a synergistic blend of essential oils and botanical extracts, each traditionally recognized for their **antimicrobial, antiparasitic, anti-inflammatory, antiseptic, and wound healing** properties. It provides natural, effective skin care and parasitic control for animals.

Specification

Product Form

Indications

Dosage and Route of Administration

Handling and Disposal

- Use in well-ventilated areas
- Avoid inhaling aerosol directly
- Wash hands after application
- Dispose of empty aluminium aerosol cans per local regulations for pressurized containers
- Do not contaminate water or feed with unused product

Details of Human and Veterinary Application

- **Veterinary:** Suitable for cattle, buffaloes, sheep, goats, dogs, horses, camels, and other animals needing herbal skin care and parasite control.
- **Human:** Not intended for human use.

Special Instructions

- Conduct a patch test before full application to check for allergic reactions
- Maintain good hygiene of treated areas
- Consult a veterinarian for prolonged or severe conditions
- Keep detailed treatment records for herd management
